#### **Rapid Shelter Columbia Sponsorship**

Delta House, Inc. adopted Rapid Shelter Columbia as its signature annual project. RSC encompasses 50 Pallet shelters and the former Inclement Weather Center (IWC), now known as the Rapid Shelter Overflow. There are a total of 50 (40 for men, 10 for women) single occupancy Pallet shelters on the Rapid Shelter Columbia Campus. Rapid Shelter Columbia serves single men and women, 18 years of age and older who are chronically homeless. Rapid Shelter Columbia is located at 191 Calhoun Street.

## HISTORY

The first facility was purchased in 1979 and named "The Delta House." It was located at 2308 Haskell Avenue, Columbia, SC 29204.

The purchase of The Delta House was initiated by members of a public service organization for the purpose of serving the community.

The vision was to provide a venue to offer programs and services that would impact the lives of people in Midlands communities.

On February 20, 1980, Delta House, Incorporated was chartered by the SC Office of the Secretary of State and is recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as a 501 ©(3) non-profit organization.

On February 24, 1993 the Delta House on Haskell Avenue was sold and on June 27, 1992 the property was purchased at 5307 Fairfield Rd, Columbia, SC 29203.

This property was redeveloped into the Delta Life Development Center where it remains today.

## GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

### GOAL:

## MEMBERSHIP

**Membership in Delta House, Incorporated consists of financial members who contribute annually in the named categories.**

The named categories of membership of Delta House, Incorporated are:

#### A. Board of Directors.

1. The Board of Directors shall consist of persons elected by the membership.
2. Qualifier: a) Persons elected to serve on the Board of Directors shall contribute \$120 annually by June 15. (Calendar year: January 1 through December 31). b) Persons elected to the Board of Directors shall be eligible to participate in the voting process of DHI.

#### B. Friends.

1. Friends shall be persons who contribute at least \$100 by June 15 annually. (Calendar year: January 1 through December 31).
2. Qualifier: a) Persons who contribute at least \$100 by June 15 annually shall be eligible to participate in the voting process of DHI.

#### C. Patrons.

1. Patrons shall be persons who contribute financially to DHI.
2. Qualifier. a) Patrons shall be persons who contribute financially less than \$100 annually.
3. Qualifier. b) Patrons shall not be eligible to participate in the voting process of DHI.

#### D. Corporations.

1. Corporations shall be organizations that contribute financially to DHI.
2. Qualifier. Corporations shall not be eligible to participate in the voting process of DHI.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- ▶ The Delta House, Inc. membership meets annually.
- ▶ The Board of Directors meets a minimum of six (6) times during the calendar year, to exclude the retreat, annual meeting, transitional meeting and orientation. (Note: This would equal a total of nine (9) meetings).
- ▶ Board members are required to attend a minimum of four (4) meetings during the year to maintain their position on the Board.
- ▶ Persons interested in serving on the Board of Directors may apply for the Board of Directors when the application process is announced.
- ▶ Persons interested in applying for a seat on the Board of Directors should contribute the annual amount of \$120 by June 15 which is prior to the submission of the Board of Directors application.
- ▶ The number of seats on the Board of Directors may be found in the Bylaws.
- ▶ From the Bylaws (Section 4.2. Members.) The elected Board of Directors shall consist of twenty-five (25) persons with three (3) seats filled by community persons. There shall be two (2) classes of eleven (11) persons. Three (3) community persons shall be elected. One (1) shall be elected with a designated class and two (2) with a second designated class.
- ▶ Three (3) elected seats on the Board of Directors are filled by persons from the community.
- ▶ The calendar and fiscal year for the Board of Directors is January 1 through December 31.
